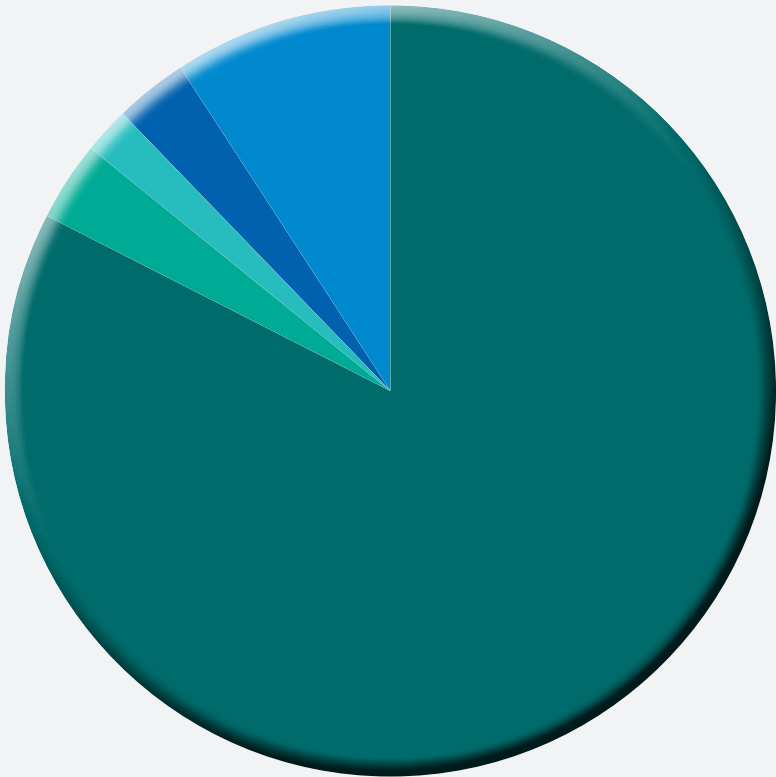

In summer 2025, the Carlisle Cannons U18 Girls made history as the first CAYS team ever to win a U.S. Youth Soccer Presidents Cup National Championship. After battling through double overtime in the semifinals, the Cannons defeated an undefeated Illinois team 2-0 in the finals to bring the national title home to Carlisle.

Their achievement is a powerful reminder of what Youth Development is all about: giving young people a place to work hard, dream big, discover their potential and achieve more than they ever thought possible.

Some traditions are more than a date on the calendar—they're a reason to come together. At the 24th Annual Carlisle Family YMCA Turkey Trot Presented by Penn State Health, 3,195 participants created the largest field in race history. The 5K included 1,939 runners and 1,250 walkers, with participants representing 33 states and the District of Columbia, while six joined virtually.

For more than two decades, the Turkey Trot has given friends, families and neighbors a place to move, connect and celebrate. It's a Thanksgiving tradition that brings our community home for the holidays.
