COVID-19 RESPONSE FAQ

Q: Does my child have to wear a face mask at camp?

A: Staff should wear masks or cloth face covering when feasible. Campers must always have a mask or cloth face covering with them, but they only have to wear them when indoors and in close quarters for extended periods of time. This includes when they are riding in the bus or van. Campers do not need to wear a mask when outside.

Q: What happens if my child becomes sick during camp?

A: If a camper becomes ill or begins to show signs of COVID-19 while at camp, the following protocol is in place:

- The camper will be self-quarantined in the isolation room (FFC Office) until they can be picked up by a parent or guardian to seek medical advice (must be within 2 hours).
- Camp staff will collect information regarding all areas of contact with the camper within the last 48 hours.
- Camp administration will notify staff and campers of the potential exposure.
- The Carlisle Family YMCA will arrange for professional sanitization company to service the areas of use at the camp facility.
- The camper may not return to camp until they have been fever-free for 3 days (suspected case).
- The camper may not return to camp until they have been symptom-free for 10 days (positive case).

Q: What if one of my kids has a fever at drop-off, but the others do not?

A: Anyone who is in the same drop-off vehicle with someone who fails the screenings also will be denied entry into camp that day.

Q: Will campers still be going on field trips?

A: Due to the local busing company not providing transportation for the month of June and public entertainment being closed, our June field trips have been changed to guest speakers/entertainers coming to the YMCA. That schedule is still being finalized and will be sent out once confirmed.

Q: How will you encourage social distancing during camp?

A: We will be encouraging social distancing through increased spacing, small groups, limited mixing between groups and staggered scheduling whenever feasible.
